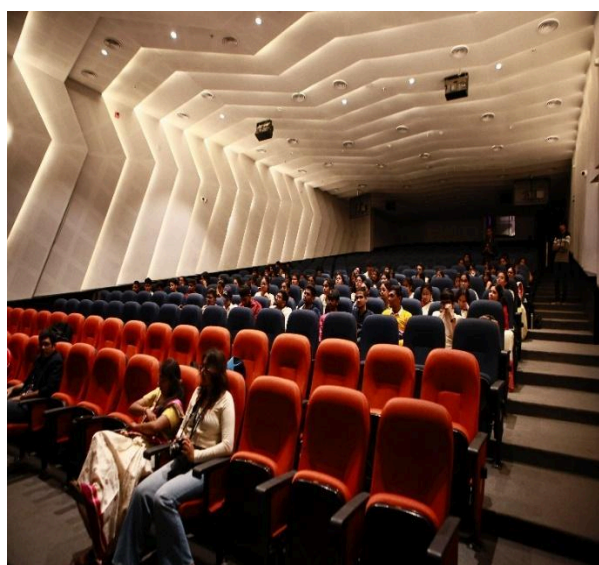
Objectives of the Event:
